

## **Carolyn Ann Weiner Scholarship**

Bishop Rosecrans High School was heartbroken when Carrie Weiner, a 1997 graduate of Rosecrans died. At the time of her death, she was a sophomore at Ohio Dominican College majoring in Elementary Education.

At the age of 9, Carrie fought hard to win the battle against a tumor that left her partially paralyzed after surgery. She fought hard to be treated normally by her teachers, peers and family members. Carrie did not allow the tumor and its consequences to prevent her from enjoying life to its fullest and preparing for her dream of becoming a primary school teacher. For Carrie, higher education was not an option: it was a necessary component of success.

The Carolyn Ann Weiner Scholarship has been established to honor a student like Carrie who highly values education and takes responsibility for education seriously. The recipient of this scholarship should show the same kinds of qualities that were reflected in Carrie: determination and drive to succeed, motivation to do as well as possible at all times, and strength of character which enables one to push ahead despite obstacles which fall in the way.
